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Read this user's manual before use to ensure proper operation. Keep the manual on hand for reference in case there is a problem.

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START International warrants all parts on the TDH2O1 tape dispenser against defects in design, materials and workmanship for a period of 360 days. Parts excluded from this are: cutting blade, springs; these parts are considered "wear parts". Labor to replace defective parts will be performed at no charge for the first 180 days after date of purchase. Warranty does not cover transportation costs.

Our sole obligation under this warranty is limited to repair, replacement or credit of the purchase price, at our option, for units that do not perform properly the function for which they were designed.

Warranty repair is contingent upon our examination and determination that alleged defects have not been caused by misuse, abuse, improper installation or application, repair, alteration, accident or neglect in use, storage, transportation or handling.

The above warranty and remedy constitutes START International's sole liability hereunder and are in lieu and exclusive of all other warranties and remedies expressed, implied, or statutory, including, but not limited to, those of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.

Contact START International to determine nature of problem.

Furnish START with the following information:

- 1. Who the unit was purchased from.
- 2. Model number and serial number.
- 3. Date purchased (copy of invoice or packing slip required).

Start will issue an RGA (Return Goods Authorization) for the repair.

Return machine to Start International by UPS, insured and prepaid.

Start will notify the customer if there is a repair charge.

A \$25.00 evaluation charge will apply to all non-warranty repairs, and will be applied to subsequent repair charge.

NOTES

- Do not leave tape dispenser in direct sunlight.
- Do not drop the dispenser or subject it to heavy shock.
- Do not insert fingers into the tape outlet.

FEATURES

- Quick-change length setting. No tools required.
- Large capacity water bottle.
- Stainless steel tape guides.
- Triple brush moistening system.

DESCRIPTION OF PARTS AND FUNCTIONS




- Water Bottle Reservoir for water tank.
- Water Tank / Brush Wets tape as it feeds through dispenser. Water level is adjustable.
- Handle Stop Sets feed length.
- Knob Allows for adjustment of Handle Stop.
- Handle Dispenses and cuts tape.

SET-UP

- 1. Remove the tape holding the reel guides and upper tape plate. (For shipping purposes only.)
- 2. Remove bottle.
- 3. Remove water tank by tilting it back and pulling forward over the front lip.
- 4. Remove brushes from water tank and wash with soap and warm water. Rinse brushes to ensure removal of all soap residue.
- 5. Replace brushes in water tank. Brushes must be angled toward the front of the dispenser. Installing


backward will lead to tape jams. (Figure 1)



- 6. Replace water tank.
- 7. Fill bottle with clean water. Place finger over fill hole and replace bottle into holder. Water level can be adjusted by turning the screw on the water tank.

TAPE LOADING

- 1. Adjust reel guides to fit tape width.
- 2. Place tape roll, adhesive side down, into the back of machine between the reel guides.
- 3. Manually feed tape:
 - Over the lift roller
 - Over the metal guide bar
 - Under the upper tape plate until the tape is up against the shear blade. (Figure 2)




ADJUSTMENTS

Wetting of Brushes

 Adjust the height of the water bottle by turning the screw in the water tank. Higher to apply more water, lower for less water.

Tape Feeding

• The position of the lower feed wheel can be adjusted by using the set screw on the feed assembly. This can be accessed through the large hole in the support bracket. (Figure 3)




If the tape is slipping and not feeding consistent lengths, turn the screw clockwise to raise the feed
wheel. If the tape is being torn or scored by the wheel, turn the screw counter-clockwise to lower
the feed wheel.

Roll Guides

• Raise the roll guides on the metal bar until the guides can slide along the bar. Place the roll guides into the slots that are just wider than the width of the tape. To set roll guides, pull the guide down into the slot on the metal bar and then slide the guide into the bottom slot.

OPERATION

- 1. Check covers to make sure they are securely closed.
- 2. Lift Knob and adjust Handle Stop to required length. (Figure 4)
- 3. Pull Handle to Handle Stop then release handle. (Figure 5) (The return action of the handle cuts the tape.)




MAINTENANCE

Weekly


- 1. Wipe shear blade with clean cloth. Use IPA for adhesive build-up on blade.
- 2.. Remove water tank, brushes, and bottle. Wash with warm water and soap.
- 3. Remove upper tape plate and brush out paper dust.


Monthly


- 1. Add several drops of light machine oil to blade oiler. This is done by pulling the oiler away from the blade.
- 2. Gently push the oiler back into position against the blade.





